

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Urban Development Corporation, doing business as the Empire State Development Corporation (“ESD” or the “Corporation”), pursuant to Section 16(2) of the New York State Urban Development Corporation Act (Chapter 174, Section 1, Laws of 1968, as amended) (the “Act”), has adopted a General Project Plan (the “Plan”) with respect to the Oswego – RESTORE II – Oswego Harbor Revitalization Project (the “Project”), at the Directors' meeting on August 16, 2010. Copies of the Plan are available without charge to any person who shall make a request for the same at the office of the Corporation. The Corporation will file such Plan in the office of the Oswego County Clerk at 46 East Bridge Street, Oswego, New York, and in the office of the Oswego City Clerk at 13 West Oneida Street, Oswego, New York. A copy of the Plan is also on file at the principal office of the Corporation, 633 Third Avenue, New York, New York 10017, and is available for inspection by the general public Monday through Friday, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

The Project includes a 36,000 square foot expansion of the existing Best Western Captain’s Quarters Hotel and Conference Center located at 24 East First Street, Oswego, New York. Total Project costs are expected to be approximately \$5,000,000. ESD proposes to make a \$1,000,000 grant to the City of Oswego to assist in the financing of the Project.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with Section 16(2) of the Act, a public hearing, open to all persons, will be held by the Corporation at the Oswego City Hall located at 13 West Oneida Street, Oswego, New York, on August 30, 2010, at 2:00 p.m., to consider the Plan.
